



## DUTY OF CARE

LUMIN8 FOOTBALL has a duty of care, a responsibility, to ensure that your child and/or children are safe during all training sessions that we provide. We always act in the best interest of our players and staff within surrounding communities. The collection and dismissal of a child from any LUMIN8 FOOTBALL training session will only be permitted if a nominated parent / carer is present or if there has been a prior written notice of instructions given to our team.

As part of our responsibility, LUMIN8 FOOTBALL upholds and is obligated to the following:

- Make appropriate checks prior to the sport activity to identify and remove hazards from the environment in which the activity takes place.
- Educate participants to undertake the activity safely as possible (this includes ensuring that participants learn and understand the rules of the sport and wear the correct protective clothing/equipment if required e.g., shin pads and football boots)
- Supervise participants as they undertake football activities particularly if they are children or young adolescents.
- Ensure that there are persons on hand who can respond appropriately to emergencies. This usually involves the provision training and the development of procedure e.g., qualified staff and medical emergency services.
